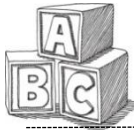


Curriculum Guide

Our Goal is to offer curriculum activities that will promote a love of learning and encourage curiosity while boosting problem solving and scientific thinking skills.

Our Letter of the Week curriculum is a full 26 weeks that is designed to expose our 3's, 4's and 5's to the alphabet through hands-on activities. Learning about letter formations, phonemic awareness, and personal letter journals are avenues we use to teach pre-reading/writing skills.



Along with our Letter of Week Program, we also incorporate themes that include holidays and seasons to round out our curriculum. Example themes include:
